PANTHEON OF EGYPTION GODS

- 1. Anubis god of embalming and the dead; portrayed as a man with a jackal head
- 2. Bastet protective goddess; portrayed as woman with the head of a cat or a cat
- 3. Amun King of the gods; portrayed as a man with a ram head, a ram, or a man with an ostrich-plumed hat
- 4. Aten form of the sun god Ra; portrayed as a sun disk with rays that end in hands
- 5. Atum a creator god, believed to be the first god to exist on earth; portrayed as a man with a double crown
- 6. Hathor protective goddess; goddess of love and joy; sometimes thought to be the mother of the pharaoh; portrayed as a woman with the ears of a cow or with a headdress of horns and a sun disk
- 7. Horus god of the sky; protector of the ruler of Egypt portrayed as a man with the head of a hawk or a hawk
- 8. Ma'at –goddess of truth, justice, and harmony; associated with the balance of things on earth; portrayed as a feather or a woman with a feather on her head
- 9. Isis protective goddess; used magical spells to help those in need; portrayed as a woman with a headdress in the shape of a throne or with a pair of cow horns with a sun disk
- 10. Osiris god of the dead and ruler of the underworld; portrayed as a mummified man with wearing a white cone-like headdress with feathers
- 11. Ra the sun god; portrayed as a man with a hawk head and a headdress with a sun disk
- 12. Thoth the god of writing and knowledge; portrayed as a man with the head of an ibis holding a writing tablet, an ibis, or a baboon
- 13. Nephthys protective goddess of the dead; portrayed as a woman wearing a headdress showing her name in hieroglyphs
